People around the world have observed spiritual and religious seasonal days of celebration during the month of June. urger King to Withdraw Advert The fast food company is to withdraw an advert shown in Britain and Spain after protests by the Mexican government. The ad for a Burger King Texican depicts a Whopper fat Mexican short wrapped in the Mexican flag standing next to a tall, slim, handsome cowboy, American supposedly highlighting

the mix of influences that goes into the product. Needless to say, the Mexicans found that the ad was offensive and was stereotyping impressions of their country.

oreign Languages Needed for Jobs According to a recent study, 27% of jobs on offer in Spain require knowledge of languages as a requirement, with English being the main one, wanted in 75% of these iobs. Increased mobility of workers, globalisation, and immigration are the main factors contributing to this demand.

overnment Aid for Small BusinessesThe Spanish government has announced an aid package of 14 billion euros to help small and medium sized businesses to get through the recession. 11 billion of the money will go towards helping municipalities and government contractors pay their debts to those companies, while the remainder will be used to provide credit guarantees for the companies to cover services to local authorities. The sums are additional to the 11 billion



announced in November.

o Kidneying! The consumer association FACUA, has reported that dozens of Spanish people have put kidneys and other organs up for sale on the internet. Apparently, the offers are being made by those suffering the effects of the recession.

panish Unemployment Rate Slows unemployment figures for April showed a slowdown on the previous month's figures. The increase fell from 120,000 in March to 40,000 in April, indicating that the measures taken by the government are having some effect. With the country officially in recession this is the 13th monthly increase in the unemployment rate, with the numbers not working now at almost 4 million. Meanwhile, the government has announced that it will

ost Powerful Motor Bikes to Require Special Permit Changes to the law regarding powerful motor bikes mean that a special permit will be needed to ride machines of over 500cc. To obtain the permit it will no longer be enough simply to be of the age of majority, but it will be a requirement to be over 20, have had officially approved training and have at least two years experience on smaller bikes. There will also be a permit for medium sized bikes from 47cc to 500 cc which will be obtainable for over 18's only. The new rules will come into effect in September 2010.

pain and Italy Get Biggest EU Farm Subsidies A study, recently undertaken following freedom of information rules regarding EU farm subsidies, has found that, although France gets the biggest share of subsidies, the largest individual payments have been made to companies in Spain and Italy, with the biggest payouts last year going to three Italian firms.

udi to Build Q3 in Spain Audi have decided to build their new SUV model, the Q3, at their plant in Barcelona. The company has decided that, for the time being, there is no need to manufacture in the US, and no need to

select additional sites. Spanish PM Zapatero said that the decision would safeguard around 7500 jobs, where workers have recently voted to accept a wages freeze for two years.

Imería House Demolition Illegal A British couple whose property was kocked down in Almería province have been told by the Spanish supreme court that the demolition was illegal. Regional authorities ordered the destruction of the €600,000 Vera property in a drive against

FATHERS DAY JUNE 21 2009

Father's Day is a day of commemoration and celebration of Dad. It is a day to not only honor your father,

but all men who have acted as a father figure in your life - whether as Stepfathers, Uncles, Grandfathers, or "Big Brothers." Father's Day is celebrated on a variety of dates worldwide and typically involves gift-giving, and special dinners to fathers and family-oriented activities. In 2009, it is celebrated on June 21 in many countries (March 19 in Spain). In a few Catholic countries, it is celebrated on the Feast of St. Joseph

The History of Father's Day

The earliest record of Father's Day was found in the ruins of Babylon. A young boy named Elmesu carved a Father's Day message on a card made out of clay nearly 4,000 years ago. He wished his Babylonian father good health and a long life!

Mrs. John B. Dodd, of Washington, first proposed the idea of a "father's day" in 1909. She wanted a special day to honour her father, William Smart. He was a Civil War veteran widowed when his wife died in childbirth with their sixth child. Mr. Smart was left to raise the newborn and his other five children by himself on a rural farm in eastern Washington state. It was after Mrs. Dodd became an adult that she realized the strength and selflessness her father had shown in raising his children as a single parent. Therefore, the first Father's Day was observed on June 19, 1910 in Spokane Washington.

It took many years to make the holiday official. Where Mother's Day was met with enthusiasm, Father's Day was met with laughter. The holiday was gathering attention slowly, but for the wrong reasons: it was the target of much satire, parody and derision, including jokes from the local newspaper Spokane Review. Many people saw it as just the first step in filling the calendar with mindless promotions like "Grandparents' Day", "Professional Secretaries' Day", etc. all the way down to "National Clean Your Desk Day". In 1924 President Calvin Coolidge supported the idea of a national Father's Day. Finally in 1966 President Lyndon Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring the 3rd Sunday of June as Father's Day.

How Fathers's Day is celebrated

Roses are the symbolic flowers for fathers on their special day, much like carnations are to mothers on Mother's Day. If you wear a red rose, it's in celebration of your father who is alive and a white rose indicates that your father has passed away.

South Africans typically celebrate by taking the family on a picnic or spending the day fishing.

In Sweden, Father's Day starts by serving him his favourite breakfast in bed. The breakfast may consist of cheese, ham, assorted breads, gröt (porridge), Smörgas (Swedish open faced sandwiches), filmjölk (sour-milk yogurt) and Swedish pancakes with lingonberries and whipped cream. Served with juices and tea or coffee.

In Japan, some elementary and middle schools mark Father's Day by holding special classes on a Sunday in June. For dads who spend all their weekdays working, this is a rare chance to see firsthand how their kids are doing in class.

In Germany there is no such thing as Father's Day as celebrated throughout the western world but there are two celebrations with similar names: Vatertag, is always celebrated on Ascension Day and regionally, it is also called men's day, Männertag, or gentlemen's day, Herrentag. It is tradition to do a males-only hiking tour with one or more small wagons, Bollerwagen, pulled by manpower. In the wagons are wine or beer (according to region) and traditional regional food, Hausmannskost, which could be Saumagen, Liverwurst, Blutwurst (Blood Sausage), vegetables, eggs, etc.



eartworm or Dirofilariasis is a potentially fatal parasitic disease that primarily affects dogs, ferrets and cats are also very rarely affected. It is transmitted from an affected dog by the bite of a mosquito. The parasite is a roundworm, which as an adult lives in some of the blood vessels around the heart and in the heart itself. The mature female produces free-swimming larvae, which the mosquito picks up when it bites an affected animal. This larva develops in

> the mosquito and in 2-3 weeks becomes infective for other dogs bitten by said mosquito. This larvae, back in a dog, travels through the blood stream to the heart where it matures and completes its life cycle. This process takes about six months: one infested dog can be a reservoir for an

entire neighbourhood, no breed is immune.

Your veterinarian would suspect this disease if you live and/or have travelled to a mosquito infested area and bring in your pet with some of the following symptoms: laboured breathing, coughing, tires easily, listless and/or weight loss. These may be symptoms of other problems as positive, a treatment program should be initiated as soon as possible. Over 90% of dogs treated for this disease survive. If the dog is negative or once an affected dog is cured preventative measures should be instituted.

This is one disease your dog may be affected by even if you do not live in an area identified as having heartworms, your pet could bring this home from a holiday or an outing to an affected area.


Presently, much research is being done with many phases of this disease. Up until only recently, within the last few years, the only preventative measure available was an oral medication, which had to be taken on a monthly basis. We now can offer an annual vaccination against this disease, which has its advantages here due to our climate and seasonality of the mosquito vector. By discussing this disease with your veterinarian and instituting the optimum preventative measures in your case, heartworm need not be a problem for you or threaten your pet.







■he night of June 23rd, or Sant Joan as it is known in Spain, is a huge celebration, without a doubt one of the most traditional and popular days. Since ancient times, just at the arrival of the summer solstice on the evening of June 21st, people have welcomed in the warmer weather with celebrations of fire, the ritual flames consuming all as a sign of rebirth and renewed life.

The origins of the celebration are indeed ancient; however they are also equally mysterious. There are some who believe it goes back to the Neolithic Age, when pagan celebrations were held to give strength to the sun god and thank him for the year's harvest. One important aspect of the summer solstice is that it marks the longest day of the year and is therefore followed by the shortest night, so from that moment forward, the daylight hours begin to wane.

Over time, this pagan tradition became christianized by the Church of Rome, who had it coincide with the anniversary of the birth of Saint John the Baptist. This adaptation to Christian ritual occurred in the 5th century of the Christian era.*

Although varying in specific regional traditions, the celebration has remained constant to the verve and popularity for which it became known, bringing together communities and groups of families and friends to participate in the annual holiday. For centuries now, places near and far all over the European continent have glowed luminously with fire, one of the most essential, yet one of many equally important elements associated with this celebration.

As it happens, it is in Spain where the evening celebrations of Saint John have remained true with the passing centuries, being celebrated with particular intensity in its towns and cities. Traditions such as Les Falles d'Isil in the Catalan Pyrenees, La Crema deth Haro in the Vall d'Aran, the unique celebrations held in Ciutadella and the Fogueres in Alacant, all intensified with the arrival of the flame from El Canigó, symbolizing the united cultural identity of Catalan-speaking lands.

SYMBOLIC ELEMENTS

Fire is the most fundamental element associated with the Saint John's Eve celebration, as since ancient times it has symbolized renewal and the giving of thanks for bountiful harvests. However it isn't the only symbolic element. One other element is water: a magic and purifying element which is inevitably linked to the Christianization of the celebration. Saint John, according to Christian tradition, was the hermit who baptized Jesus in the waters of the Jordan river. The magical properties that have been popularly attributed to water on Saint John's Day are endless, which is in sharp contrast to the Catholic Church strictly forbidding contact with water or even washing oneself on Saint John's Day.

Lastly, one other important element worth mentioning belongs to the



A NIGHT FULL OF MAGIC

Saint John's Eve is one of, if not the most magical of all nights. A myriad of rituals associated with fire and water have been passed down over the ages that still exist today. There are traditions such as leaping over the bonfires to free oneself from sicknesses and bad omens; or the healing properties associated with the morning dew and a wide variety of summer herbs and plants that cause warts, herpes and skin diseases to disappear, while at the same time bringing good luck and fortune. Besides, according to the tradition, Saint John's Eve is the night when the wishes of those in love are brought into being by way of ancient spells and incantations. Also a number of rituals to enhance fertility abound on this day. And to top things off, witches gather and plot a myriad of twisted events, as well as share rituals using magic potions known only unto them. As you can see, there is no lack of magical elements associated with Saint John's Eve.

OTHER TRADITIONS

Saint John's Eve and the following day of the Feast of Saint John the Baptist are full of ancient traditions. Obviously the celebration held on the night before the Saint's Day, also known as the **'verbena' is the most popular. People light bonfires, firecrackers and fireworks, decorate their balconies and celebrate until the early hours of the morning. One other tradition that finds its origin in ancient times are the 'ordalies'. or a sort of trial by ordeal, consisting of a ritual closely linked to the young unmarried women living in rural areas. In order to predict the identity of their future husband, they follow such rituals as breaking an egg into PREVIOUS YEARS ISSUES a container full of water. The young women use the shape taken by the CAN BE FOUND ON OUR egg white to sense what tools their future husband will use to work the land. As regards gastronomy, traditional foods eaten on this day were ring-shaped cakes, gradually popularized into the tasty fruit 'coca' pastries eaten today. There are even cocas filled with creams and 'cabell The Cherry Festival in d'àngel' (a sweet pumpkin filling). Common beverages include 'vi ranci', literally 'rancid' wine, as well as sweet wines, popularized by the Catalan www.miravet.altanet.org cava consumed today. * Although the Church incorporated the celebration

ith so many homes in Spain for sale right now, buyers really are spoilt for choice. Gone are the days when they would hesitate before making a cheekily low offer, so be sure to maximise your property's appeal and don't give buyers any extra opportunities to negotiate a price reduction.

Avoid spending too much money on your property trying to 'do it up' to sell — simple cosmetic improvements are the most worthwhile in the current market. Ask your real estate agent what's worth doing, and keep it simple.

1. Kerb appeal. Entrances, drives, facades, outside areas etc. are the first thing prospective buyers see, and first impressions are the strongest. These areas should be neat and well presented. A freshly painted facade, front door etc. can make a big difference.

2. Clean up. It sounds obvious, but dirty windows, dusty furniture, stale smells etc. are a total turn-off for potential buyers. Get everything clean and sparkling, air your home before a viewing, and be sure to get rid of pet odours.

3. De-clutter. Clear mantelpieces, windowsills, dressers and tables of unnecessary clutter. This can make rooms look bigger and focuses attention on your house, not your possessions. If you have lots of personal photos, consider removing some: they can be distracting.

Also, a spare room can easily get full of junk — try to clear it out before a viewing.

> 4. Repaint walls and ceilings in light, neutral colours if they aren't already. If you can't redecorate throughout, at least repair any paintwork that's flaking or in poor condition, especially anything that could appear to be damp-related.

5. Kitchen makeovers. The kitchen is the heart of any home and, along with the living room, is the area that buyers will focus on most. If your kitchen is looking tired but doesn't warrant

a full refit, you can update old-fashioned kitchen units by replacing just the cabinet fronts.

A new work surface can make a huge improvement, especially if you change the sink too. It's worth bearing in mind that Spanish buyers favour granite-type worktops over laminate ones, even in a holiday home.

6. Update light fittings. Give your property a brighter, caredfor feeling by updating light fittings, ideally with ones that use halogen or low energy bulbs. Many solar/generatorpowered country properties are very dimly lit, something I find often puts off buyers: improvements are worth considering. And when you have a viewing, remember to turn all lights on and open blinds etc., before buyers arrive.

7. Home staging. Staging is the art of preparing a home for a sale, and many techniques cost next to nothing to implement. You'll find plenty of information on the internet. Get a few home magazines for inspiration (include Spanish

ones), find a simple, unfussy look to emulate, and pamper, de-clutter, polish and tidy your house.

8. Buyers respond to light. No-one likes gloomy interiors so make the most of natural light sources and supplement with lamps, candles and mirrors and reflective surfaces.

9. Use scents that say "home"... fresh baked bread or cakes, cinnamon, vanilla and fresh coffee subtly create a welcoming atmosphere for buyers. The most important? Fresh air, so be sure to open all windows and air out the house before a viewing.

10. Sell smart. Finally, you, the seller. People buy people (and lifestyles), and few will be impressed if you answer the

door in a dirty track suit with food debris down the front! I'm not suggesting you don your choicest Armani togs to show your *finca*, but it's a thought worth bearing in mind.



Welcome to Olives & Popcorn, your monthly guide to great Spanish based films that in my opinion should not be ignored.

Any comments are welcome. Also if you want to know more about a particular film and how to get a copy again get in touch via my email below.

This month I present another film set during the Spanish civil war but this modern classic was brought to my attention when given away as a freebie in the Independent Newspaper.

And now I have the opportunity to bring it to you......

.....Land and Freedom (Drama)

Land and Freedom is a 1995 film (alternative title: Tierra y Libertad) directed by Ken Loach and written by Jim Allen. The movie narrates the story of David Carr, an unemployed worker and member of the Communist Party of Great Britain, who decides to fight for the Republican side in the Spanish Civil War. The movie won the FIPRESCI International Critics Prize and the Prize of the Ecumenical Jury at the Cannes Film Festival.

The film's narrative unfolds in a long flashback. David Carr has died at an old

age and his granddaughter discovers old letters, newspapers and other documents in his room: what we see in the film is what he had experienced in his life.

Persuaded of the necessity of helping the Spanish Republicans in their fight against the fascist Nationalist insurgence, Carr, a young unemployed worker and member of the Communist Party, leaves Liverpool and travels to Spain to join the International Brigades. He crosses the Catalan border and casually ends up enlisted in a POUM militia commanded by Lawrence, in the Aragon front. In this company, as in all POUM militias, men and women — such as the young and enthusiastic Maite — fight together. In the following weeks and months he becomes friends with other foreign volunteers,

like the French Bernard, and he falls in love with Blanca, a member of POUM, who is also the idealist of his group.

After being wounded and recovering in a hospital in Barcelona, he finally joins — in accordance with his original plan and against the opinion of Blanca — the government-backed International Brigades, and he witnesses first-hand the Stalinist propaganda and repression against POUM members and anarchists; he then returns to his old company, only to see them rounded up by a government unit requiring their surrender: in a brief clash Blanca is killed. After her funeral he returns to Great Britain with a red neckerchief full of Spanish earth.

Finally the film comes back to the present, and we see Carr's funeral, in which his granddaughter throws the Spanish earth

into his grave after speaking lines from "The Day Is Coming", a poem by William Morris. Afterwards she and the other family members perform a raised fist salute, honoring his beliefs and suggesting that his family





ostgardeners are wondering how to reduce the cost of completing the design and planting of their new garden or the maintenance of their already established garden. Well luckily there are four things that can be done with little effort or initial expenditure.

PLANT SENSIBLE PLANTS

With tighter family budgets it makes sense to only buy plants that truly match the microclimate of your garden so search through Part Four of our book 'Your Garden in Spain - From planning to planting and maintenance' paying special attention to their frost and drought resistances, whether good in containers or near the sea etc.. If you are on the coast consider planting more perennial plants that flower year after year to replace annuals that need daily watering and only flower for half the year. If you live inland recognise that all subtropical and tropical plants are an expensive risk.

BUY SMALLER PLANTS

Firstly they are less expensive and secondly smaller plants often settle in the garden quicker than larger plants and can indeed catch up after the first few months or year or two depending on the type of plant. The main reason is that the root ball of the smaller plants are normally sufficient to support a newly planted plant in the garden whereas the

> larger – often forced plants –may have restricted roots in a pot of a diameter much smaller than the width of the plant. In the latter case the roots need to grow before they can support the next stage of growth in the garden.

GROW YOUR OWN PLANTS FROM CUTTINGS

If you have not done this before it can be easier than you think and your home grown plants will cost almost nothing. Chapter 6.12 of 'Your Garden in Spain' explains how to do so step by step.

GROW YOUR OWN PLANTS FROM SEEDS

Most packets of seeds are inexpensive and

contain easy to germinate seeds for both flowering plants and vegetables. More care is required than in raising plants from cuttings but again easy to follow instructions are given in Chapter 6.13 of 'Your Garden in Spain ' and in Chapters 4.12 and 4.13 of 'Growing Healthy Vegetables in Spain'. The catalogue of www.chilternseeds.co.uk includes thousands of flowering plants from around the world and www. semillassilvestres.com sell hundreds of types of Spanish wild plant seeds just right for inland natural gardens.



For an MP, that's like adding crack cocaine to a bottle of chocolate heroin."

A committee of senior members from across the House is now drafting emergency legislation that will make it illegal to import a television larger than 19 inches, while the government is urging Japan, Germany and South Korea to convert their



My browser window opens too small. Your web browser remembers the size it was last used at, so if you or a web site have changed the size it will appear like this the next time you start your browser.

To set the correct size, start your browser and hold your mouse over the corner of the window until you see the resize arrows, then click and drag to change the size, then close the browser. When you next start your browser the window should open at the same size.

Some Web sites do not display correctly. If particular web sites are not displaying correctly - with errors, missing buttons or images, links that do not work, incorrect layouts - this may be due to your browser security settings, which can block parts of a web site it decides are potentially unsafe (though there may be nothing wrong with them, it is just being cautious).

To change security settings in Internet Explorer click on the Tools menu then Internet Options, but be careful as changing to a low security setting might let unsafe content through to the PC.

There may just be a problem with the web site itself, in which case try again later.

Web page text is too small. You can increase the size of text on a web page by clicking on the View menu (Page in Internet Explorer 7) at the top of the browser window, then select Text Size and choose a larger size. This should work with most text on web pages though not all.

My browser address bar has disappeared. Click on View

from the menu at the top (or Tools in Internet Explorer 7) then Toolbars. Click to tick the Address Bar option and it should reappear.

How can I get rid of pop-up adverts? To stop adverts opening in new windows you need a pop-up blocker. Both Internet Explorer 6 and Firefox have built-in pop-up blockers. In IE go to Tools > Pop-up blocker to turn it on or change your settings.

How can I tell if a web site is secure before buying? To know whether a site is secure before you give your credit card details, look at the address bar and make sure the web address begins with https://

There should also be a padlock symbol on the address bar (or at the bottom of the page in older versions of Internet Explorer) to indicate the site is secure.

How do I print only certain text or images from a web page. Rather than printing out a whole web page, you can select the particular text you want and copy it to a Word document, and then print it out.

Start Microsoft Word and minimise it by clicking on the minimise button at the top-right of the window. Now open your web browser window and click and drag your mouse pointer across the text you want to highlight it. Rightclick and Copy. Return to Word by maximising it from the taskbar, right-click and Paste. You can repeat this process as many times as you like to get all the text you want into one Word document.

You can copy and paste most images in the same way by right-clicking on the image and clicking Copy. Alternatively you can choose Save As to save a picture to somewhere on your PC, for example the Desktop or My Documents. Then in Word, click Insert then Picture From File. Click to select the picture you have saved then click Insert.

You can then Print your document. By using Word you also have the ability to rearrange, edit and resize text and images before printing.
